It is with great sadness that the family of Edgar Lee Ellender, Jr., 75, announce his peaceful passing on Saturday, September 29, 2018 at Westwood Nursing Home in DeRidder, LA. He was born in Lake Charles to Edgar Lee Ellender, Sr. and Emma Scanlan Ellender on July 9, 1943.

A native and long-time resident of Lake Charles, LA, Ed graduated from Marion High School and proudly served in the United States Navy.
