Rev. Deacon Franklin Sumner Kohlhund, 90, of DeRidder, LA, passed from this life on Tuesday, September 18, 2018 in DeRidder, LA. Sumner, the son of Franklin Butler and Grace (McDonough) Kohlhund was born on November 3, 1927, in Audubon, New Jersey.

Rosary services will be held Friday, September 21, 2018, at 9:30 AM, at the St. Joseph's Catholic Church in DeRidder, LA, Mass will start at 10:00 AM, with Father Jude Brunnert, M.S. and Monsignor Danny Torres officiating. Reception will immediately follow at Kern Hall.

Sumner was a deacon at St. Joseph's Catholic Church for 40 years. He performed numerous weddings, baptisms, and funerals. Other services he provided include catechism instruction, visitation of the sick and shut in.

Many will remember Mr. Kohlhund from his service to DeRidder High School band boosters as well as his volunteer work at K.R. Hanchey Elementary.

He was a United State Navy veteran, serving at Naval Air Station, North Island, Coronado, CA.
