Funeral services for Louvenia "Mama Caze" LaCaze, 101, of Hicks will be held Thursday, January 4, 2018, at 2 pm at the Hicks United Pentecostal Church in Hick, LA. Burial will follow in the Hicks Cemetery, under the direction of Labby Memorial Funeral Home of Leesville.
