Funeral services for Odell F. Estes, 94, of DeRidder will be held at 11 A M, Monday, November 7, 2016, in Pleasant Hill Baptist Church, DeRidder, LA with Bro. Chad Estes and Rev. Danny Wilson officiating. Burial will follow in Pleasant Hill Cemetery, DeRidder, LA, under the direction of Labby Memorial Funeral Home in DeRidder. Visitation will be held Sunday, November 6, 2016, from 5 P M until 9 P M at Labby Memorial Funeral Home, DeRidder, LA and from 10 A M until time of the service, Monday, November 7, 2016, in the church.

Mr. Estes was a native of Bushnell, Swain County, NC, the son of John Wesley and Lular Ivalee Brooks Estes. He was born September 5, 1922, and passed away Thursday, November 3, 2016, in Beauregard Memorial Hospital. He lived most of his life in DeRidder, LA.
