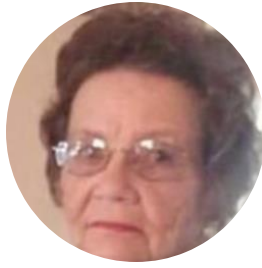

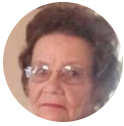


Elaine Sephronia Burns
