Vergial Prentice Kay was born in Fair Dale, Texas on May 27, 1926, to Elsie Ramona McGraw Kay and Tommy Albert Kay. He passed away on Tuesday, August 16, 2016, in DeRidder.

Vergial Prentice Kay was a retired boilermaker welder for over forty years. During World War II, at a very young age he and one of his older brothers wanted to join the United States Army. To their surprise, they were turned away. Still wanting to do something for his country he went to a Texas ship yard and started building military water vessels for the United States Military. Those close to him knew him as a humble, filled with compassion, loving, and a man with a natural ability to make others, laugh.

When death was at his door, he said, I trust my Savior, He made me and He will take care of me, and when He wants me, He will take me.

He was preceded in death by his parents; wife of forty three years, Mearlean Marie Kay; two sons, Vergial Paul Kay and Billy Wayne Kay; one grandson, John Roy Lawrence.
