Winfred Eugene “Bo” Maum, 82, passed away peacefully at his home Saturday, February 20, 2016. He was born on February 12, 1934, in Longville, LA, to Haywood and Maudie Allmon Maum. He was preceded in death by his parents, sister, Merrell Chamblee, and son-in-law, George Harsch. Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, February 24, 2016, at 11 A.M., in Labby Memorial Funeral Home Chapel with Tim Bergen officiating.
