**F**uneral services for Malcolm L. Cole, 75, of Hornbeck, LA will be held at 10:00 AM Wednesday, June 10th, at the Labby Memorial Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Tim Leach officiating. Burial will follow in the Prewitt's Chapel Cemetery in Hornbeck, under the direction of Labby Memorial Funeral Home of Leesville.

Visitation will be Tuesday, June 9th, from 5:00 PM until 9:00 PM and then Wednesday, June 10th from 8:00 AM until service time in the chapel.

Malcolm, the son of Lewis and Fourthie Jones Cole, was born November 8, 1939 in Plainview, LA. He passed away at his residence in Hornbeck, Saturday, June 6, 2015.
