Marjorie Cole Pollard, age 85, of Leesville, passed away on November 11, 2014. She had lived in Leesville all her life. Mrs. Pollard was born November 19, 1928 in Peason, La.

Preceding her in death were her parents, Bill and Euna Cole, her husband, Claiborne F. Pollard, her brother, Charles W. Cole, and her son-in-law, Larry E. Monk.

She is survived by one daughter, Charlotte P. Monk, one son, Kenny W. Pollard, of Leesville, and wife JoAnn, four grandsons, Jeffrey Monk, of Houston, Timothy Monk, of Baton Rouge, Mark Pollard and wife Holly, Jonathon Pollard and wife Leila, and three great-grandsons, Wyatt, Gabriel, and Noah Pollard.
