Funeral service for William Gerald Slaydon, 87, of Longville, LA, will be held at 11:00 A.M., Saturday, March 22, 2014, at First Baptist Church of Longville with Rev. Stuart Graves officiating. Burial will follow in Magnolia Cemetery, Ragley, LA, under the direction of Labby Memorial Funeral Home of DeRidder, LA.

Visitation will be held on Friday, March 21, 2014, from 5:00 PM until 9:00 PM at First Baptist Church of Longville, and will continue on Saturday, March 22, 2014, from 9 A.M. until time of the service at the church.

Mr. Slaydon was born on February 17, 1927, to William Jessie Slaydon and Dolly Vogie Bailey Slaydon in DeRidder, LA. He lived in Westlake, LA, for most of his life before retiring and moving to Longville. He was an Operator at City Service Oil Refinery from which he retired.
