Funeral services for Rodger D. Causey, 64, of Leesville, Louisiana will be held at 10:00 am Saturday, August 10, 2013, at the First United Methodist Church in Leesville with Rev. Hank Hamilton officiating. Burial will follow in the Laurel Hill Cemetery, under the direction of Labby Memorial Funeral Home of Leesville.

Visitation will be held Friday, August 9th from 5 pm - 9 pm, at the funeral home and on Saturday, August 10th, from 9 am until time of service at the church.

Rodger, the son of Huey P. and Betty Danzy Causey was born March 6, 1949, in Leesville. He passed away Wednesday, August 7th at his residence in Leesville.

Rodger graduated from Leesville High School in 1967 and attended Northwestern College. He coached at Leesville Junior High School and Leesville High School for many years and touched the lives of many young people throughout Vernon Parish. His passions in life were golf, football and his country. He attended First United Methodist Church in Leesville.

He was preceded in death by his father, Huey P. Causey.
