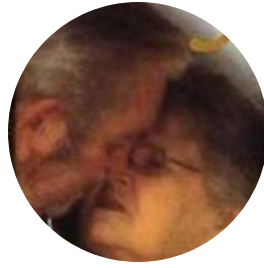

Funeral services for Darlene Dee Ganaway, 78, of Leesville, Louisiana will be held at 11:00 a.m. Wednesday, December 19, 2012, at Christian Living Fellowship Church with Bro. Bobby Ganaway officiating. Burial will follow in the Central Louisiana Veterans Cemetery, under the direction of Labby Memorial Funeral Home of Leesville.

Visitation will be held from 5 p.m. - 8 p.m., Tuesday, December 18th, and on Wednesday, December 19th from 9 a.m. until service time in the church.

Darlene Dee Ganaway was born on December 12, 1934 to Tannyhill and Maggie Granger. She was number 5 of their 8 children. It was evident early on that she would not be lost in the shuffle.
