**F**uneral services for Kenneth G. Reid, 69, of Sugartown, LA, will be held on Thursday, August 23, 2012, at 10 AM at Shiloh Baptist Church in Dry Creek, LA, with Rev. Rod Martin officiating. Burial will follow in Shiloh Cemetery under the direction of Labby Memorial Funeral Home of DeRidder.

Visitation will begin on Wednesday, August 22, 2012, at 2 PM until 9 PM, at Shiloh Baptist Church in Dry Creek, and will continue Thursday at 9 A.M. until service time at the church.
