James Paul "J. P." Galloway, Jr., 89, of DeRidder, LA, passed away on Thursday, June 9, 2011, at his residence.

Visitation will be held on Sunday, June 12, 2011, from 5 P.M. until 9 P.M. and Monday, June 13, 2011, 9 AM until the time of the service, both days at the funeral home.

He was born on April 25, 1922, in DeRidder, LA, the son of Carolyn Clopton Galloway and James Paul Galloway, Sr.
