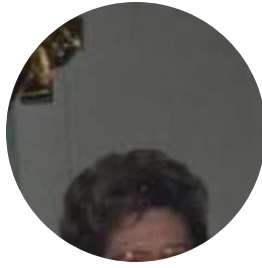

She leaves behind her husband of 69 yrs. Huey P Gilcrease of Leesville, LA.

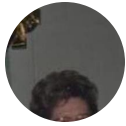
Sons: William” Bill” Gilcrease and wife Debbie of Leesville, LA; Danny Gilcrease of Leesville, LA.
