**F**uneral services for John Edward Cryer, 70, of Leesville, Louisiana will be held at 2:00 p.m. Sunday, December 12, 2010 at Labby Memorial Funeral Home Chapel in Leesville with Monsignor Salvator Collota and Rev. Wallace Palmer officiating. Burial will follow in the Forest Lawn Cemetery in Leesville. The services are under the direction of Labby Memorial Funeral Home of Leesville.

Visitation will be held from 5 pm - 9 pm, Saturday, Dec 11th and then 9 am until service time in the funeral home Sunday, Dec 12th. A Rosary will be recited Saturday, at 7:30 PM in the funeral home.

Edward, the son of J. T and Thelma Thornton Cryer, was born July 23, 1940 in Leesville. He graduated from Leesville High School in 1958, and on April 23, 1960 , he married his high school sweetheart, Annie Rose Wilson. They had three sons together, and celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary this past April.

Edward was retired from Holsum bakery after more than 30 years of service. He worked as a distributor and as a supervisor. For over 20 years he owned and operated Cryer's Sports. He was a member of the St. Michael's Catholic Church.
