**H**oward P. Dean, 91, passed away Monday, May 24, 2010, in his residence in DeRidder. Funeral services will be held at 11 A.M., Wednesday, May 26, in Labby Memorial Funeral Home Chapel in DeRidder with Rev. Dale Miller officiating. Burial will follow in Beauregard Cemetery under the direction of Labby Memorial Funeral Home in DeRidder.

Mr. Dean was born in Sarepta, Louisiana, and lived most of his life in DeRidder. He was a retired Senior Operator with Mobile Oil for thirty-five years. He was a highly decorated veteran of the U. S.
