Funeral services for Noel D. Townsend, Sr., 78, of DeRidder, will be held at 1 P.M., Wednesday, April 7, 2010, in Labby Memorial Funeral Home Chapel in DeRidder, with Rev. Bill Warrean officiating. Burial will follow with full military graveside services in Beauregard Cemetery in DeRidder.
