Thomas J. "Tommy" Brown, III, 52, of DeRidder, Louisiana, passed away Monday, November 2, 2009, in Beauregard Memorial Hospital in DeRidder. Tommy graduated from DeRidder High School in 1975 and worked at Boise Cascade Paper Mill for 30 years. He was also the owner of a Quiznos in Lake Charles, Louisiana. Tommy was an avid golfer and the Senior Club Champion at Beauregard Country Club.

He is survived by his wife, Kay Shirley Brown; two sons, T. J. Brown of DeRidder, and Jared Bass and wife Cresa of Katy, Texas; one daughter, Whitney Bass of Lake Charles; mother, Patricia T.
