Mr. Perry passed away Friday, December 26th in Lake Charles, LA

He was born Fulsom, Oklahoma he retired from the US Army after 20 war of service, during that time he had 3 tours of duty in West Germany, 2 tours to South Vietnam and 1 tour to South Korea. After his retirement from the Army he worked for the City of Leesville Fire Department. He further volunteered for the Red Cross.
