Evelyn Stagni Scalfi passed away peacefully in her home on April 7, 2021.

She was born Evelina Marie Stagni on November 13, 1926 to Stella Allemand and Domain Joseph "DJ" Stagni in Lockport, Louisiana. She lived her childhood in Houma before moving to New Orleans to attend Soule's Business College after graduating from high school. It was in New Orleans she met the love of her life, Robert A. "Bob" Scalfi, Jr. They married on April 15, 1950 and lived in New Orleans until Bob was recalled for active duty in the Korean War. Evelyn moved back to Houma while Bob was at war.
