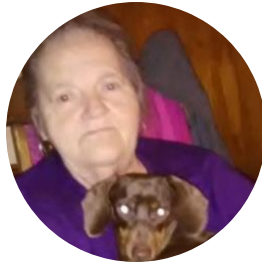

Throughout her life Irene was a loving, devoted and extraordinary daughter, sister, wife, mother, grandmother and friend.

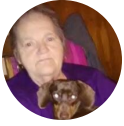
Irene's special gift was that she never met a stranger and could talk and make friends with anyone. She was also a great cook and loved it when she was able to feed you one of her wonderful meals.
