He served in the Korean War and the Vietnam War. He was awarded a Purple Heart following the Korean War along with other military honors through the years. Among his military decorations are the Purple Heart and Bronze Star along with other military honors. Dave worked in civil service as an industrial hygienist for 15 years at Fort Polk. He received a bachelor or arts in education degree from Northwestern State University in 1981. Dave was a member of the First Baptist Church DeRidder for 42 years and was a charter member of the DeRidder Optimist Club. He was a proud supporter of DeRidder High School athletics. Dave played minor league baseball for the Chattanooga Lookouts. He also coached Dixie Youth League baseball and softball.



He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister and brother-in-law, Gloria and James Brown.
