Walter Lloyd "Mac" McKenney, 60, of DeRidder passed away Monday, January 23, 2017 at St. Patricks Hospital following several years of illness. Mac was born in Lafe, Arkansas, grew up in several different states but called Mississippi his home state. He enlisted in the U.S. Army at age 17 and completed his high school education there followed by an Associate Degree in Diesel Mechanics.

He retired from the U.S. Army as a Chief Warrant Officer 3. His Awards included Army Achievement Medal, Army of Occupation Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Good Conduct Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Overseas Service Ribbon, Driver and Mechanic Badge, Parachutist Badge, and Retirement Lapel Button.
