Mrs. Myrtle June Brewer Johnson was born in a farm house in Ike's Community to Mr. and Mrs. John A. Brewer on June 6, 1933. She went into the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ on March 24, 2022.

June graduated from DeRidder High School in 1951. She attended Northwestern University on a music scholarship, then transferred to Louisiana College.
