Funeral services for Fred Sills, Jr. of Leesville will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday, Jan 27th at Labby Memorial Funeral Home in Leesville with Reverend Tommy Kiker officiating.

Family visitation will be at 11a.m. with public visitation from noon until 2 p.m. The graveside service will be at 11:30 a.m. on Friday, Jan 28th at Kilpatrick's Serenity Gardens in West Monroe.

Fred Jr. was born July 23, 1930 in Portland, AR and went home to be with the Heavenly Father January 20, 2022 in Alexandria. He was preceded in death by his parents Pleasie F. Sills, Sr. and Eunice (Whitney) Sills, brother Robert Sills, sister Lena Mae Maza. He is survived by his wonderful wife of 66 years Peggy J. (Calloway); sons William "Freddy" (Susan), Robert "Bob" (Candy), Sherwood Alan (Kristy), and daughters Joan Shoults (William), Janell Titschinger (Rick), Janice Titschinger (Mike), Jennifer Stanley (Richard), Judith Boswell (Randolph); brother Irving L.
