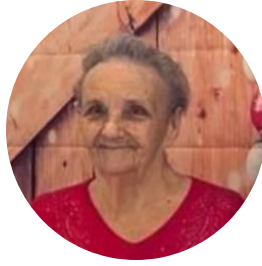

Lucille Sieren, 84, passed away in her home surrounded by her family on Friday, November 11, 2022. 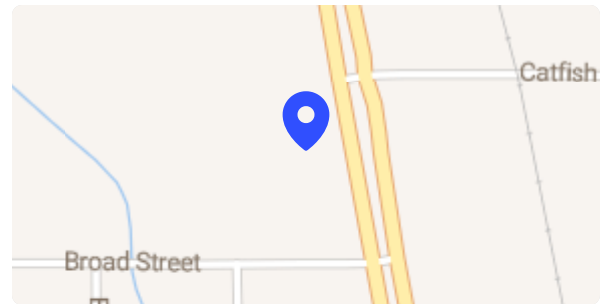

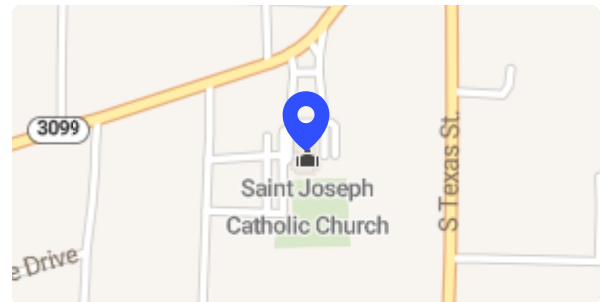
