His main occupation was driving a school bus for Pickering High School for 42 years. During this time he also owned several convenience stores and an amusement business for the soldiers at Fort Polk. He served as president of the Ward 4 Water Board for 20 years.

He was a loving family man who loved to laugh and was a big jokester. His hobbies included tinkering with cars, dirt track racing, restoring a 1962 Chevy Impala, and he was an avid coin collector. He was well know and appreciated in his community. If anyone was in need and called, Buddy was there to help. He was a member of Cooper Baptist Church in Pickering, LA. Buddy was a very attentive father and grandfather. To Buddy's surprise and delight, he discovered just one year ago that he had a son, Ron, from a previous relationship. They were over joyed to have found one another. He loved life and the Lord and left many to honor his memory.

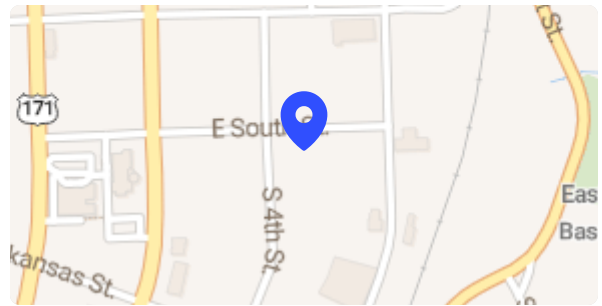

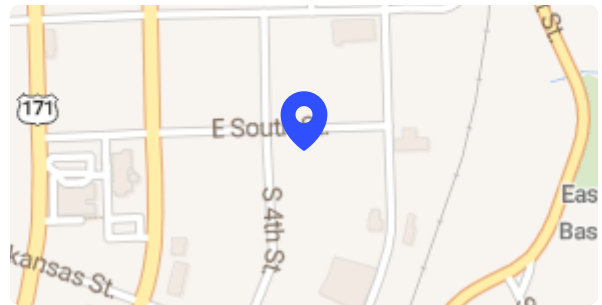
