Husband of Charles (Chuck) Snyder, Bill was born in Leesville, LA on April 18, 1952. Billy, who's family refers to him as Luzon, his middle name, was the youngest of four children. Preceded in death by his parents Wid Cryer and Adel Cryer neé Nash, late of Rosepine and his brother David Larry Cryer, Sr.

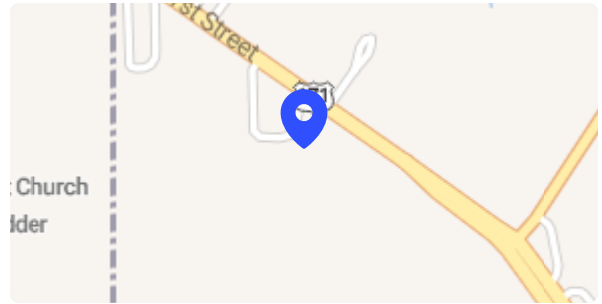
