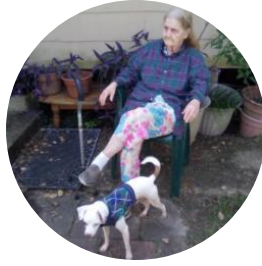

The memory of Lois Davis will live on through those who knew and loved this remarkable woman - may we honor her legacy each day through acts kindness towards others just like she did throughout hers!






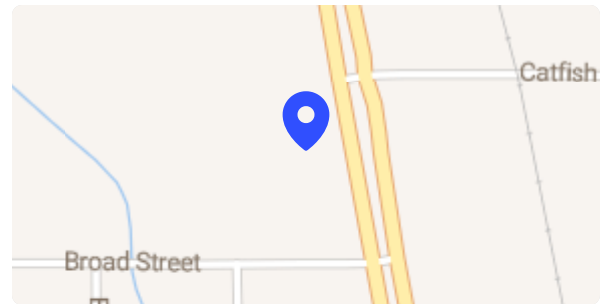
